A Brief Overview of the Programs

Bachelor of Computer Application (BCA)

- This program equips the students thoroughly with the necessary qualification, knowledge and skill for a rewarding career in business and industry as Computer, Information Technology, Information system and Systems Administration etc. Students will be able to pursue higher education at the master's degree level or any other higher qualification in India or abroad.
- From banks to game designing firms it is easy to find job with relevant knowledge and skills in big MNCs all over the world.
- PROGRAM DURATION: 4 Years
- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: 10+2 (passed in any stream) from W.B.C.H.S.E. or any other recognized Council / Board are eligible to apply for BCA program. However, the candidate(s) is required to undergo a Bridge Course and qualify in the examinations to be conducted, who have not studied and not passed in Mathematics/Computer Science / Computer Application at 10+2 level.



BCA in Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning

- BCA in Artificial Intelligence & Machine Learning program is a specialized undergraduate program designed to provide students with a strong foundation in computer science along with advanced knowledge of Artificial Intelligence (AI), Machine Learning (ML), Data Science, and emerging technologies. The course aims to develop analytical, programming, and problem-solving skills required for modern IT and intelligent system development.
- PROGRAM DURATION: 4 Years
- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: 10+2 (passed in any stream) from W.B.C.H.S.E. or any other recognized Council / Board are eligible to apply for BCA program. However, the candidate(s) is required to undergo a Bridge Course and qualify in the examinations to be conducted, who have not studied and not passed in Mathematics/Computer Science / Computer Application at 10+2 level.





Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA)

- The Bachelor of Business Administration program is designed to equip students with both knowledge and essential skills. The curriculum balances theoretical learning with practical exposure, including communication and soft skills. Graduates can pursue careers across banking, finance, marketing, FMCG companies, BPOs, and research organizations. The demand for skilled business administration professionals remains evergreen, and organizations are eager to hire competent and efficient graduates.
- PROGRAM DURATION: 4 Years
- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Candidates should have passed 10+2 (passed in any stream) from W.B.C.H.S.E. or any other recognized Council/Board.



BBA in Travel & Tourism Management

- The BBA in Travel & Tourism Management program is highly beneficial for students as it provides comprehensive knowledge of the tourism industry, hospitality services, travel operations, and destination management. The program develops managerial competence, communication skills, customer service expertise, and entrepreneurial ability required in the dynamic global tourism sector. The course prepares graduates for professional careers in travel agencies, airlines, hotels, tour operations, cruise lines, tourism boards, and international hospitality organizations. With the continuous growth of domestic and international tourism, the programme offers promising career prospects, global mobility, job stability, and opportunities for higher studies and specialization in tourism and hospitality management.
- PROGRAM DURATION: 4 Years
- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Candidates should have passed 10+2 (passed in any stream) from W.B.C.H.S.E. or any other recognized Council/Board.



BBA in Hospital Management

- BBA in Hospital Management Program in collaboration with Tamralipta Government Medical College & Hospital (Formerly Purba Medinipur District Hospital (Tamluk), Govt. of West Bengal).
- Healthcare delivery systems and services have become one of India's largest sectors in terms of both revenue and employment. Multi-speciality and super-speciality hospitals, nursing homes, and other healthcare institutions increasingly function like corporate organizations, requiring skilled manpower to manage their operations. The program equips students with the necessary qualifications, knowledge, and practical skills to pursue rewarding careers in hospitals, nursing homes, private and government healthcare facilities, medical laboratories, insurance agencies, pharmaceutical and biomedical companies, mental health organizations, public health departments, rehabilitation centres, and private laboratories.
- PROGRAM DURATION: 4 Years
- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Candidates should have passed 10+2 (in any stream) from W.B.C.H.S.E or any other recognized Council/Board.



M. Sc. in Computer Science

- M. Sc. in Computer Science program helps you to gain a scientific and practical approach to computation. This course is designed to provide a thorough knowledge and practical experience in the field of computer systems and information technology such as programming, software engineering, database management etc. With the help of dedicated faculties, students get an insight about the complex computer languages and applications. A professional degree in Computer Science prepares the students in building a solid foundation in science and mathematical principles and opens up a host of careers in the IT sector. Master in Computer Science is a great option. It can open doors to many new and exciting jobs. A career in Computer Science means that you can design and analyze new computer system, study robotics and even research artificial intelligence.
- PROGRAM DURATION: 2 Years
- ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA: Three years / four years Bachelor of Computer Applications (BCA) / Science graduate /Engineering graduates. Final year students can also apply.





Syllabus

As prescribed by Maulana Abul Kalam Azad University of Technology (MAKAUT, WB). Students are also requested to visit university website: www.makautexam.net for detailed syllabus.

Eligibility for Appearing in Semester Examination:

A student shall be eligible to appear in an examination provided that he/she pursues a regular course of study in the respective department and attends at least 75% of the theoretical, practical, and sessional classes on average held during the semester. Attendance shall be calculated from the date of the candidate's admission to the institution/college.

Mandatory Additional Requirement (MAR): Sports, Debates, Cultural Programs Blood Donation Camp, Tree Plantations, Excursion, etc.

Extra-curricular Activities play vital role in shaping students' life. From strengthening the mind to promoting better time management skills, it helps students succeed in much more than just their academic endeavors. For example, it will train students to maintain patience and resilience in the face of intense difficulty. It inculcates amongst students (a) leadership, (b) team building, (c) public speaking and (d) social responsibility attitudes.

Keeping the above objectives in view, holding and participation of every student in Sports, Debates, Cultural Programs, Blood Donation Camp, Tree Plantations, Excursion, and other Social Activities are made mandatory for award of the degree.

A student is required to acquire a total of minimum 75 activity point throughout 3 years curriculum which should be acquired by earning a minimum of 20 activity points and maximum of 30 activity points in each of his or her study.

Any conduct by a student or group of students, spoken or written words, gestures, or actions, that teases, a fresher or any other student with rudeness is considered rowdy or undisciplined activities that cause or are likely hardship, physical discomfort, or psychological harm, apprehension in the mind of a fresher or any other student,

Forcing a student to perform any act that they would not results in shame, embarrassment, or mental distress, is

act by a senior student that disrupts regular academic activities, exploits the services of a fresher for personal or academic tasks, or imposes financial burden or extortion is a serious offence. Physical abuse, verbal abuse, public humiliation, obscene gestures, or any behaviour that adversely affects the mental health, dignity, and self-confidence of a student will be treated as grave misconduct.

The institution maintains a zero-tolerance policy towards ragging. In every reported incident, appropriate action will be taken promptly, including filing an FIR with the local authorities when required. The Anti-Ragging Committee will carefully examine each case based on its nature and severity and recommend suitable disciplinary measures.

Punishments may include cancellation of admission, suspension from classes, withholding of scholarships or results, debarment from examinations and institutional activities, rustication for a specified period, or expulsion from the institution. In cases where the offenders are not identified, collective punishment may be imposed to ensure discipline and accountability. This strict framework aims to preserve a safe, respectful, and inclusive academic environment for all students.
